

Jeff Laidlaw answers the question of why he's running for Councillor, Ward 2, Nobleton / Laskay.

- On Sept 27, 2005, Council approved the subdivision proposal for 698 homes in the NE quadrant of Nobleton. Many residents still have serious concerns about water supply, traffic, the character of the proposed community, etc. Councillors Underhill and Pellegrini were the only Councillors to vote against the development as proposed.
- The \$ 400,000 arena expansion only provides increased office space for the township. What happened to the new change rooms?
- The Township has a stated commitment to protecting our heritage and yet:
A) the Township allowed the Masonic Hall / Orange Lodge to be demolished.
B) The Recreation Master Plan calls for the demolition of the Nobleton Lions / Women's Institute Community Hall.
- We now have a gazebo costing in excess of \$90,000. \$45,000 came from property tax revenue. Aren't there other priorities?
- With your help, assistance and support, I will work very hard to represent the entire community, not just special interests.
