**COUNCILLOR PETER GRANDILLI AND CANDIDATE JEFF LAIDLAW, WARD 2**

Councilor Peter Grandilli and candidate Jeff Laidlaw, Ward 2 King Township have agreed to limit election signage in the coming municipal elections.

In a meeting today Laidlaw and Grandilli agreed that election signs can create controversy within neighbourhoods, are sometimes an eyesore and are an unnecessary use of resources.

With this in mind, Grandilli and Laidlaw have agreed to limit themselves to no more than a total of 40 signs in up to 20 locations, along either Highway 27 or King Road within the ward boundaries.

We believe that the people are better served in this manner, and we will focus on issues and not sign wars.
